KEY POINTS AND VERSES

Summary: The Church has a lot of doctrine but the Church didn't just make up those teachings—the same way that people have some ideas about God. God is a God who shows Himself. He shows himself in creation, in our conscience (by you feeling bad when you do something you know is right or wrong), and clearly by the Bible. The Bible, though written by Men, is actually God speaking to us.
