KEY POINTS AND VERSES

Summary: God doesn't need anything. He is amazing great, perfectly strong, and completely different from everyone and everything. God can live fully as God without any help from anyone or anything. God is God—completely and perfectly—without anything in the world helping God to be God. God doesn't need us: we need Him

Lesson: God is God apart from us

- 1. God is Never fully understandable. (Psalm 145:3; 147:5; Isa 55:9; Rom 11:33)
- 2. God is very different from us
 - God doesn't need anything (Acts 17:24-25)
 - God owns everything good (James 1:17
 - God doesn't change (Psalm 102:25-27)
 - God is unique (Isaiah 46:9; Deut 6:4; Exodus 3:14)
- 3. God must make himself known if we're to understand Him (1 Cor 2:14)
- 4. God is uniquely able to be enjoyed (Isa 43:7; John 17:24)
