#### **Could Christ Have Sinned?**

No. God cannot sin and Christ could not do something that would stain the divine nature

#### Did Christ Use His Divine Nature to Not Sin?

**No.** As a man, empowered by the Spirit and filled with God's word, he used everything given to him by the Father (example: prayer) to remain obedient. He didn't use his divine nature; he used all the resources God gave him as a man.
