Could Christ Have Sinned?

No. God cannot sin and Christ could not do something that would stain the divine nature

Did Christ Use His Divine Nature to Not Sin?

No. As a man, empowered by the Spirit and filled with God's word, he used everything given to him by the Father (example: prayer) to remain obedient. He didn't use his divine nature; he used all the resources God gave him as a man.

Christ **could not** sin.

Christ **would not** sin.

Christ **did not** sin.
